The following position will be filled at the 2011 Diocesan Convention, to be held October 14-16 in Hermiston, Oregon:

2012 GENERAL CONVENTION LAY DEPUTY ALTERNATE

2012 GENERAL CONVENTION DEPUTIES were elected at the 2010 Diocesan Convention for a 3-year term for the **2012 General Convention, July 5-12, 2012, in Indianapolis, Indiana**. Four lay deputies and four ordained deputies and their alternates, were elected. LAY DEPUTY ALTERNATES were not elected at that time.

The DEPUTY ALTERNATE(S) will serve in place of a deputy should an elected deputy be unable to attend General Convention. The FIRST ALTERNATE will be offered the opportunity to attend General Convention and with the opportunity to serve on the floor of Convention, allowing Deputies to take time off during Convention, should they choose to do so.

The time commitment will include at least one meeting of the deputies during the year before General Convention, possible travel to and attendance at General Convention, and attendance at the Diocesan Convention in October, 2012. General Convention deputies serve for the entire triennium (2012-2015).

(2) request a LAY DEPUTY ALTERNATE CANDIDATE FORM from the person in charge of your congregation or from the Diocesan Office. **Submit completed and copy ready candidate forms to the Diocesan Office by August 30, 2011**, for reproduction in the Pre-Convention Journal. Nominations will be accepted following that date, but information about the candidate will not be published. Announcement of those nominations will be made from the floor of Convention prior to elections.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Qualification for candidacy for lay positions is "*confirmed adult communicants in good standing of some congregation in canonical union with the Diocese.*" An "*adult*" is defined as 16 years of age and older. Nominations of persons who have not served at the Diocesan level are highly encouraged. Anyone interested in these positions is encouraged to submit a Candidate Form. Attendance at the 2011 Diocesan Convention is not required of candidates but can be conducive to election.
