- *Resolution on Housing Allowance:*

WHEREAS, section 107 of the Internal Revenue Code permits a minister to exclude from gross income a church-designated allowance paid to him or her as part of his or her compensation for services as a minister, to the extent used by him/her for actual expenses in owning or renting a home; and WHEREAS the Rt. Rev. Patrick Bell is employed as a minister of the Gospel by the Episcopal Diocese of Eastern Oregon which does not provide a residence for him, Diocesan Council resolves that of the total compensation received during 2021, \$2000.00 per month shall be designated a parsonage allowance within the meaning of that term as used in Section 107 of the IRS Code of 1986. The Diocesan Council also resolves that the amount designated as housing allowance shall apply to 2021 calendar year and all future years unless amended by the Diocesan Council. minutes from the April 10, 2021, meeting as presented. Ascension School Report - Amy Jayne

Amy shared a power point presentation of slides recapping the year. Some highlights from the summer included:

- 120 campers
- 29 Ascension Camperships
- 78 Parish Camperships
- A record number of campers from Cove

The interns participated in a Sacred Ground Internship that used the curriculum from the national church. They explored cultural and historic sites throughout the region that helped them grasp the concepts that they were exploring in their studies.

There was an Outdoor School held at Ascension School this fall that is in partnership with the Grand Ronde Model Watershed Community Science Projects that is focusing on Indigenous Studies. Another Outdoor School is scheduled for the spring of 2022.

The UTO Grant that was for the heating of the greenhouse is complete and plants are already growing and almost ready to be harvested.

Many campus improvements happened across campus throughout the year, including:

- Construction of an Outdoor Chapel
- Dorm Upgrades
- New floors in Morris Hall
- Outdoor lighting installed throughout campus
- Founders Hall and Coe Kerr ADA Upgrades
- New Highway Fencing

Roman Heidrich is settling in as the new Program Director. He is currently on the east coast attending a conference specifically for Program Directors. In addition to camp programing, he is exploring creating young adult events. Katie Sanchez is the new Operations Manager. She has brought many creative ideas to the hospitality side of Ascension School. She is also planning on bringing beekeeping to Ascension School in 2022.

The Roanridge Grant provided funds to remodel the staff cabin for housing for Katie and Roman.
